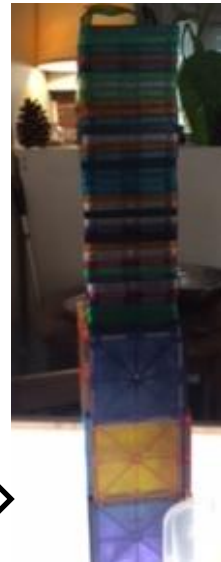
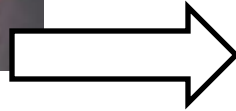
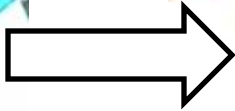
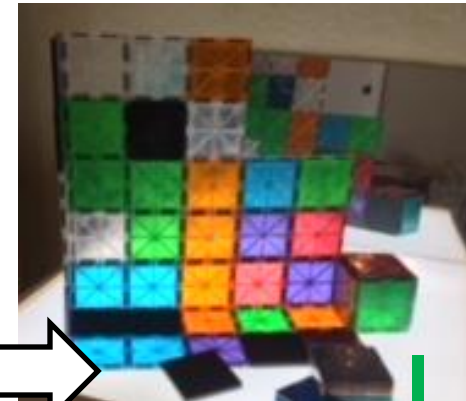
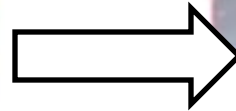
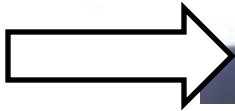
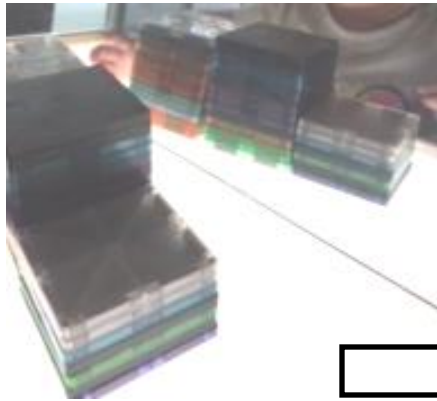


# Creating Complexity
